

Toxin Testing Policy- Wheat

Mercer Landmark Inc. will be testing for Vomitoxin levels in all wheat delivered to Mercer Landmark. The customer will have 2 options: Individual testing or Composite testing:

- 1. Individual Testing: Mercer Landmark will grade and test vomotoxin on each sample, and the customer will wait to dump until the vomotoxin sample is completed.
- 2. A composite sample of daily deliveries by an entity is an option when it is mutually agreed upon between the handler (Mercer Landmark) and depositor (Entity). The handler cannot make a depositor accept composite sampling. If a composite sample is agreed upon, all factors (Test Weight, Moisture, Damage, Vomotoxin, etc.) will be determined on the daily composite sample.

If the depositor is not satisfied with the results, they may request that a sample be submitted to the applicable federal grain inspection office for a binding grade. If the results benefit the depositor, then Mercer Landmark is required to pay for the retest. If the results match or benefit Mercer Landmark, the depositor is required to pay for the retest. The charge will be invoiced to their account.

The individual testing option is only available to customers delivering wheat to a branch that has testing equipment on site.

Mercer Landmark, Inc. reserves the right to reject loads or future loads from the same source when individual or composite samples are over 10.0 PPM Vomitoxin.
